Agenda Details:

1.	Opening Introductions. The current Chairperson, Daphne Slawson, opened the proceedings with a welcome to everyone, and especially to those new members who may be attending their first RoADAR AGM. Thanks, on behalf of the group were extended to Jon Mendez, for providing the venue for this meeting, and to David Hansford, for his attendance to give a talk to the assembled group. Daphne explained that Mark Hamilton Peach had resigned from his various RoADAR positions
	during 2014 because of pressing family commitments. There will be a presentation and acknowledgement of Mark's long service, with Hampshire RoADAR, at a later date. Those present were asked to sign Marks leaving card, placed with the purchased leaving gifts on a nearby table.
2.	Treasurers Report In the absence of a Treasurer, Alan Davis, current Secretary, announced that the Group's financial balance is £3137.36, with very little expenditure through the year, except that paid for occasional venues, along with refreshment costs
3.	 <u>Previous AGM Minutes & RoADAR Activities</u>. Alan explained that the minutes of the last AGM are available, but noted that this was an 'inquorate' session, as there were only ten people present. Positions on the committee were filled by later offers, and these were gratefully ratified at a committee meeting held on 16th December 2013. A plan to hold a further 'Special Annual General Meeting' early in 2014 did not proceed, on the basis that the decisions made would be circulated to the membership by means of an electronically processed bulletin. Mention was made that there were no activity 'Events' arranged in 2014. The core business of receiving new applications, allocating tutors, and facilitating safe driving progress to examination and final grading, has continued successfully, as outlined in the outcomes posted on the AGM agenda.

Cancellation of the proposed main activity 'Event' in April 2014 was due to lack of support from any of the main statutory agencies. It was acknowledged that most of these services continue to experience difficulties with reduced budgets and staffing levels, hence the problem of 'fielding' personnel for our training day. Alan related how RoSPA HQ had, in the following month, requested contributions from 'Care on the Road' readers about our chosen subject of ' Coping with the Unexpected' in order to complete a members survey on this subject.

4. <u>Potential Future Plans</u>

A mention was made of committee discussions about appropriate 'training' themes for 2014/15, which seem to revolve around the needs of the older driver, and indeed, younger people in terms of applying safer driving techniques. Some drivers/riders in both categories might find it difficult to acknowledge the need for some 'advisory' assistance, but further exploration through agency networking and specific campaigns could be considered.

Finally, the issue of finding accessible and appropriate venues for meetings have been overcome by the kind offer made by Jon Mendez to hold meetings in the training room at Mendez Marine, Swanick. In the event of being unable to arrange a meeting at this venue, the group will attempt to book a room at Bursledon Village Hall.
