	2) Following explanations by the treasurer regarding the implementation of some
	new procedures, it was agreed to follow and institute new, more transparent
	plans to including a "latest" financial review/report at each committee meeting.

4.	1) Cars
	There are no tests results for 2015. One awaits a test date, and two await re-
	test dates. Currently there are seven tutors listed, but only five actively
	involved in training
	2) Motorcycles
	Tutors met with Lilian (new Chief) in December 2014 - content included up
	date and planning discussion for future procedures/activities
	There are six associates undertaking training, with no one waiting tuto
	allocation. A future increase in the number of motorcycle Tutors for training
	should be a possibility
	A rider membership survey has been undertaken with positive responses to
	questions posed. Regular ride outs are likely to be planned, starting in March 2015
	Efforts continue to be made to improve communication - choice from a survey
	appears to be in the order of - emails, Facebook and/or via website listings etc
	Training events could encompass 'Roadcraft' and essential 'First Responder
	input
	A recommendation to spend an interim amount, of up to £500, for the
	purchase of radio equipment for essential communication between tutors and
	trainees, was unanimously agreed by committee

5.	Lilian will be undertaking a Website management role within the group, and
	various steps have recently been taken to delete old material and keep information
	more up to date.
	Communication with the membership could be improved, and the suggestion of a
	regular Newsletter - Winter, Spring, Summer and Autumn - was given committee
	support. There has been no response to achieve an editor for this purpose, but an
	interim offer to produce a selection of up-date notes, for a February 2015 posting,
	was accepted.

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6.	Agreement was achieved about HQ information/notices/advice being included in a
	section of any Newsletter posted on the Group website.

7.	A suggestion was made about the use of the Angel resource in the Meon Hut area
	for some training/event sessions with both motorcycle and car members -
	perhaps based on Roadcraft or similar. It may also be possible to resurrect and
	implement the failed 2014 aim of 'Coping with the Unexpected'/ 'First on Scene'
	scenario - a professional experts' name was suggested as a possible speaker.
	The objectives and aims of the Hants RoADAR group were appropriately
	questioned - with questions raised at this meeting and the AGM about focus on
	specific 'needy' groups - i.e., the young, new and inexperienced driver/riders, and
	those in the older bracket - who often desperately need 'road safety' in-put. A
	valuable and thought provoking discussion took place with no definite outcome,
	but a request for all present to give further attention to this matter, with a view to
	establishing the 'What, When and How' of implementing a service plan.

	The lack of promotional Group material was raised - leaflets, cards, logo'd
	clothing etc., - and a member offered to consider this and produce ideas and costs
	for purchase of same.
