Work under way to get more advanced tutors involved with the group, working with Colin McNeil who undertakes test for RoSPA. Meeting with Colin, RT and EJ scheduled for 02/11/21

6 Chief Tutor (Riding) Report

There are 9 active tutors (7 Mainland/2 IoW), plus Peter Tesar who remains available for some activities. Another tutor (Mark Lee) is being trained by Graham Knight.

Kev Coleman has left us (and motorcycling).

There are no applicants waiting for allocation and our IOW tutors now have three associates between them. It is fortuitous that we have taken on Graham Knight, a Diploma holder from Wokingham and Gemma Allen, an Advanced tutor, who lives in Arlesford. Graham has accepted a new associate from Farnborough as well as training Mark Lee, and Gemma has taken on one of Peter T's associates.

A steady stream of associates are being tested and we could usefully take on additional beginners.

A Tutor meeting and ride-out on 25 September and hope to do it again before year's end. It is my intention to stand down as Chief Tutor in January 2022. I'm hoping to spend more time abroad with my protégé, who is now a motorcycle GP rider (VisionTrack Honda), but hope to be able to continue with one or two associates. I am looking for a potential successor..

8 **AoB**

Raised by LdM

In anticipation of me resigning as Chief Tutor in January 2022, may I ask the committee their feelings about whether they would be prepared to offer mileage payments to Diploma holder Graham Knight (who lives in Wokingham), for RoSPA Hants business conducted South of the latitude of Andover, should he volunteer to become the Chief Tutor. He is our only other active Diploma holder, and my own feeling is that it is useful, if possible, to utilise the Diploma qualification in the Chief Tutor role. Neither of our other Senior Tutors is likely to volunteer.

The committee has no problem of	taking on the role of Motorcycle Chief
Tutor and authorises LdM to approach	with the offer.

We would ask that the initial approach to is to take on the CT role and await his response and whether he brings up the issue of expenses incurred in performing the role from outside the "defined" group area.

The committee is concerned that offering payment for incurred expenses, even from outside the group area, could set a precedent and result in unforeseen repercussions. Therefore to ensure tight financial control, the committee would need review such requests on a one by one basis.

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An alternative would be to offer part sponsorship of a RoSPA Level 3 Award course to an existing tutor, conditional on them volunteering to take on the Chief Tutor role for a specific period.

The committee feels that to offer sponsorship of a RoSPA Level 3 Award would be prohibitive considering the £1200 cost of the course. The offer to cover an Advanced tutor test, around £40, is more reasonable but would be regarded as being a derisory offer towards the cost of the Level 3 test and therefore, not worth offering.

Some discussions need to be undertaken with regard to organising an AGM whether it is at a venue or over Zoom. EJ informed committee that current year end will close on 31/10/21 and report will be available for review a few weeks later. Suggested date late November, early December.
